
THE DIVISION OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

HOW DO I APPLY?

You need the following paperwork to apply for DDD:

BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR IMMIGRATION/ CITIZENSHIP DOCUMENTS

RECORDS FROM YOUR DOCTOR OR SCHOOL SHOWING YOU HAVE A DISABILITY

MEDICAL INSURANCE CARD (IF YOU HAVE ONE)

If you are not your own guardian, you will also need documents showing who is allowed to make decisions for you.
