Comprehensive summer programs are available starting the summer after the student's freshman year in high school and age 14.

Services provided will assist with successful transition from high school to post high school vocational services.

Services will move students forward, toward meaningful work.

Comprehensive programs include training in:

- Travel Skills
- Communication
- Personal and Home Management
- Self-Advocacy
- Daily Living Skills (Braille, Cooking, etc.)
- Assistive Technology Equipment and Training
- College or Career Exploration
- Preparing for Work
- Employment

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
