### Actions I Can Take

- Hold high expectations for job seekers who have disabilities; expect and believe that all people who have disabilities can work with the right supports
- Promote informed choice by providing information, creating options, and respecting the decisions of people who have disabilities
- Keep up to date on strategies for increasing employment opportunities for people who have disabilities; remain open to new ideas and models
- Collaborate with other state agencies, schools, nonprofits, and employers to align systems and supports; join coalitions and communities of practice
- Develop programs and policies that meet the needs of diverse disability communities, including people who have significant disabilities
- Involve people who have disabilities when creating programs and policies
